Shoalhaven Community Transport Service assists people living independently within the Shoalhaven area who are frail aged or have a disability, their carers, and people who are transport disadvantaged.

Volunteers are integral to our Service. We are always looking for bus drivers, car drivers, assistants and administrative helpers.

Volunteering gives you the opportunity to support your community, meet new people and socialise with other volunteers.

Volunteering with Shoalhaven Community Transport Service offers the opportunity to provide a valuable service to those who need it most. Our volunteers help people to remain independent by assisting with transport to local medical appointments, social support groups and shopping, as well as out of area medical appointments.

Meet like-minded people

Are you a 'people person'? Do you enjoy being part of the community? Do you have patience, understanding and enjoy helping others?

If you have answered 'yes' to any of these questions, please call us. Minimum C Class driver licence is required for car drivers and LR Class for our minibuses. Relevant legal checks will be conducted.

Free training and reimbursement

Our volunteers receive free, ongoing training in Work Health and Safety and other relevant work practices, such as assisting people who are vision-impaired, dementia awareness and cultural awareness, to ensure the best possible service for our Service Users.

Our volunteers also receive a uniform and are reimbursed for kilometres travelled to and from home.
